

# Psychology Student Internship Application

## Overview

This application is for students seeking placement in a supervised psychology internship or practicum. Internships are designed to provide applied learning experiences aligned with academic program requirements and professional development goals.

## Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- Currently enrolled in a graduate psychology-related program
- Meet their institution's practicum or internship eligibility criteria
- Demonstrate academic standing in good standing
- Obtain approval from their academic program (if required)

## Application Components

Applicants must submit the following materials as a single application package:

1. Completed Internship Application Form
2. Current Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Résumé
3. Unofficial Academic Transcript
4. **Statement of Interest** (1–2 pages), addressing:
  - Academic background and program of study
  - Career interests and learning objectives
  - Relevance of the internship to professional goals
5. Proof of Enrollment (if applicable)
6. Two Professional or Academic References
  - Include name, title, organization, email, and phone number

## Optional Supporting Documents

- Writing sample (academic or clinical)
- Research proposal or summary (if research-focused placement)
- Letter of support from faculty supervisor

## Application Review Process

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. Selection is based on:

- Alignment between applicant goals and internship scope
- Academic preparation and professionalism
- Availability of appropriate supervision

Shortlisted applicants may be invited to participate in an interview.

## **How to Submit Your Application**

1. Combine all required documents into **one PDF file**.
2. Name the file using the following format:  
**LastName\_FirstName\_PsychologyInternship.pdf**

## **Application Deadlines**

- Fall Placements: June 1, 2026
- Winter Placements: September 1, 2026
- Spring/Summer Placements: January 1, 2027
